

## DIPLOMA OF PHYSIOTHERAPY AND REHABILITATION SPECIALIST

In the Diploma in Physiotherapy, you will learn how you can help patients improve their mobility as well as manage pain and other chronic conditions. A physical therapist assistant is someone who plays an integral role in helping patients recover from injuries. In this course, you will study the different structures and functions of the human body that you need to understand as a physical therapist.

A Diploma in Physiotherapy is a diploma in the paramedical field that candidates can pursue if they want to work with and treat patients who have physical disabilities or have been injured. The diploma duration is academic year (9 Months) and it teaches different rehabilitation techniques to candidates that must be applied to patients so that they can return to a normal lifestyle.

The curriculum for the Diploma in Physiotherapy has been designed in such a way that students can acquire scientific knowledge, understand how to solve problems, and develop technical and communication skills.
